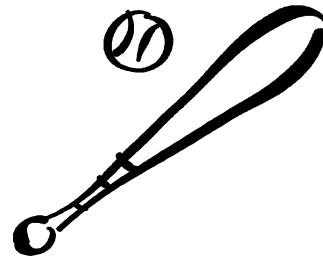

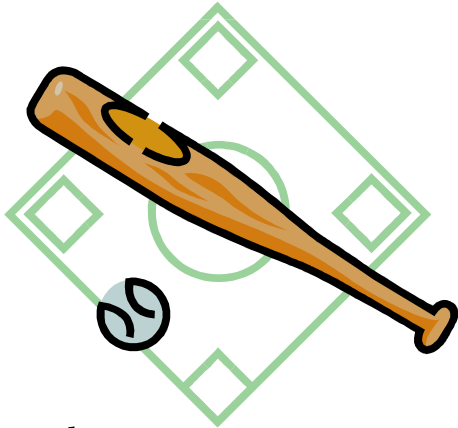
Any player, league age 9-12 years old, not currently on a Major team, *must try-out.*

- Players must try-out to be eligible for the Major or Minor-A divisions or selected to an All-star team. (excludes 6yo)
- Division placement of a player who has missed try-outs will be decided on at the discretion of the Board of Directors and will only be eligible for Minor A division.
- 8 year olds interested in playing Minor A may only try-out with Player Agent approval, and will be required to remain in Minor A, if drafted. There is not guarantee they will be put in the Minor A draft. That will be at the discretion of the board.
- 6 year olds interested in playing Minor B must have played 1 year of Little League T-Ball and attend the evaluation tryout. They will only be moved up after player agent has reviewed the evaluations.
- All candidates who are league age 12 must be drafted to Little League Major Division team or to a Junior League team.

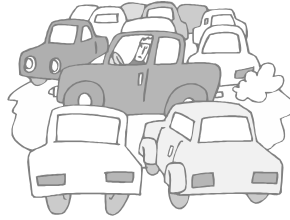
Earn \$20 working behind the plate, \$15 working the bases.

Parking & Pet Issues



We all know that parking is not the easiest at the Morada Fields. Here are a couple of guidelines to help everyone.

- » NO parking in the fire lane.
- » **NO parking in the driveway from the school parking lot to Morada fields parking lot!! You will be towed.**
- » NO parking in the front of Davis School on the red lines or in the dirt islands.
- » Be considerate of the surrounding neighbors. Do not park in their driveways or areas on their property that are entrances or exits.
- » **NO parking in the court near the back of school on Nassano.** there is already a chain across there, but do not park outside this area either.
- » Park inside the lines that have been painted in the little league parking lot.
- » If you are parking in the Morada fields parking lot and you are not in a parking stall, then you are probably illegally parked. Please do not park there.
- » All golf carts must park in the grass areas. Please do not take up the parking spaces.
- » Golf carts **MUST** be driven by an adult when in the Morada parking lot.
- » Pets – There are absolutely **NO PETS** allowed at the fields. You will be asked to take your pet home.



IF YOU ARE PARKING WHERE YOU ARE NOT SUPPOSED TO, YOUR CAR WILL BE TOWED. THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.
